Participation Fee will be \$50 per game. This fee will be paid before you leave the diamond after your last game. Baseballs will be provided by the host team.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

Read your 2007 Handbook

Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield before their first game.

Please report to the field one hour before your game time and have your lineup card given to the official scorer one half hour before game time.

All team members and coaches must be in full uniform. No shorts allowed.

A coin flip will determine the home team for each game. The loser of the coin flip will have their choice of dugout. Beaver Dam will always occupy their home dugout.

Suspended games will be completed.

WIAA Designated Hitter rule will apply in the AA tournament.

The Beaver Dam batting cage will be divided in half so both teams can take hitting before the game. Also there are two diamonds within walking distance that are available for hitting.

Beaver Dam has a full service concession stand and carry-ins are not allowed. Please inform your parents, fans and supporters of this.

In case of rain and time is critical, we do have access to an additional field.

Directions:

Sauk Prairie, Baraboo, and Portage:

Enter Beaver Dam on highway 33. Travel past the Dairy Queen and Washington Elementary School on your left. The second corner past the school should be Burnett St. Turn left onto Burnett St. and continue through town on Burnett St until you see the diamond on your right, just past McKinley Street.

Waupun and Ripon:

(I think you know how to get to the diamond.)

Enter Beaver Dam from Hwy 151 taking the exit for Hwy 33. Turn right at McDonald's and drive through the parking lot for Piggly Wiggly and Shopko. Turn left onto the street (Prospect) and at the next corner turn right onto McKinley Street. Drive straight until the street ends. Turn right and you will see the baseball field on your right.
